**OFFICE CIRCULAR**

Sub.: Announcement of valid nomination papers for the Election of (i) Professors-in-Charge of the Six Scientific Divisions, (ii) Head, SQC & OR Division, (iii) One representative from the Scientific Workers of the Institute, (iv) One representative from the Non-Scientific Workers of the Institute and (v) Two representatives of each of the Seven Divisions (including SQC & OR) on the Academic Council, for two-year term commencing from 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 and guidelines in connection with the Election.

The nominations for Election to various offices of the Council and the Academic Council, as mentioned in the subject, which were received on or before 4-00 p.m. of Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2024 in terms of Office Circular No. CAF/Elec/10-3/06 dated 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2024, were taken up for scrutiny by the Election Officer category-wise on 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2024 from 11-30 a.m. in the conference room of the CE (A&F) as per the election schedule in presence of the contesting candidates and / or their authorized representatives.

1. As announced, withdrawal of nominations, if any, should be communicated in writing by the candidate concerned to the undersigned by 4-00 p.m. of 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.
2. Elections, where necessary, will be held on Thursday, 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 in the outlying Centres/Branches/Offices/Units and on Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 in the Headquarters at Baranagar.
  - 2.1 Booths will be erected in Baranagar Campus of the Institute for voters attached to the Headquarters at Baranagar to enable voters to cast their votes personally by ballot.
  - 2.2 No voters are allowed to carry Mobile Phone(s) inside the Polling Booth.**
  - 2.3 For outlying Centres/Branches/Offices/Units etc., election papers, including ballot papers, where necessary, will be mailed well in advance so that the voters, after completing all formalities, can send back ballot papers, duly cast and completed, to the undersigned through the respective Heads of outlying Centres / Branches / Offices / Units etc. so as to reach the office of the Election Officer on or before Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 (up to 5-00 p.m.). A voter of such outstation centre may, at his/her own risk and responsibility, after collection of necessary ballot papers from the respective Heads, send ballot papers, duly cast/completed

directly, so as to reach the undersigned on or before Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 (up to 5-00 p.m.).

3. Those voters of Headquarters of the Institute at Baranagar, who might remain temporarily away due to official duties from their normal places of work but anywhere within country, will be allowed to cast their votes by postal ballot, if they make such request in writing and forward the same to the undersigned through their respective Heads. Requests of this nature should be sent preferably by 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 but not later than 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2024 (up to 1-00 p.m.). Similar facilities will be extended to voters of outlying Centres/Branches/Offices/Units etc. provided they make such request in writing and furnish their addresses to their respective Heads, in such a manner that the concerned Heads can send the ballot papers to their addresses. In such cases, voters of outstations may send ballots, duly cast/completed, etc., to the Election Officer directly if it is considered necessary and pertinent by them to avoid any loss of time which might occur, had the same been channelized through the Heads of Centres / Branches / Offices / Units under the given circumstances.

Guidelines for voters of outlying Centres/Offices etc. regarding polling by ballot in connection with Election by and from workers for various offices of the Council for the next two-year term commencing from 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2024, are being sent under a separate circular and would be published in the Institute's website.

All concerned workers are requested to co-operate for smooth conduct of the election.
